Within the next few months, a Trustee Selection Committee will be formed and accept applications for new Trustees.

If you are interested in supporting your community in this important matter, please consider putting your name forward.

Roles & Responsibilities of Trustees

- ▶ ensure the Nak'azdli Whut'en Trust Agreement is followed;
- ▶ undertake training through the National Aboriginal Trust Officers Association
- ▶ set budgets each year for Trustee activities such as accounting, monitoring investments, writing reports, and overseeing the annual audit;
- ▶ keep community and Council informed about the state of the Trust and answer any questions about the Trust;
- ▶ when the Trust is able to release money to Nak'azdli Council, Trustees will approve submitted Strategic Plan.

Who can be a Trustee?

- must be a member of Nak'azdli Whut'en
- must be at least 19 years of age
- must not be financially insolvent (involved in a bankruptcy)
- must be of sound mind and capability
- must pass a criminal record check

You can apply to be a Trustee even if you are an employee of Nak'azdli Whut'en Administration, Nak'azdli Health, or any of Nak'azdli Development Corporation's businesses.
